The challenges of Legal Archiving

Following the financial scandals in the early years of the 21st century and under pressure from shareholders of listed companies, the French Government has considerably tightened regulations governing computerized accountability. They have also imposed new methods in the calculation of corporate earnings and have chosen to use these in the fight against tax evasion. The storage of accounting data should be done in a timely and efficient manner to demonstrate the validity of company's accounting. Otherwise, a company may face back duty VAT or corporation tax. In the most extreme cases, management may be held criminally responsible and could face imprisonment.

Some Statistics

Since 2006, the French Tax Authority has been given targets in respect to the number of audits to be carried out and the means deployed in these investigations.

With 34.4% of companies investigated for fraud and the duration of tax document retention reaching 3 to 6 years for companies, the French Government is able to regularly monitor all companies.

The performance of the Tax Authority in 2007 is reflected in the following figures:

- + 10.9% back duty levied in taxes on companies,
- + 18.5% increase in fines,
- + 10.5% VAT files corrected,
- + 74% in back duty!
