A former partner at PwC, Philippe was a member of the National Activity Review Committee (*Comité d'Examen National d'Activité* or CENA) and the Committee for Ethics of CNCC (*Compagnie Nationale des Commissaires aux Comptes*: the French national auditing body). Philippe chaired the *Institut Français de l'Audit et du Contrôle Internes* (IFACI), the French chapter of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA), between 2003 and 2006, and the European Confederation of Internal Auditors (ECIIA) between 2003 and 2004. Since 2009, Philippe has been a member of the board of the *Haut Conseil du Commissariat aux Comptes* (H3C), the French public authority charged with supervising the audit profession, successively chairing the Committee on Quality Controls and the Committee on International Affairs.

Philippe is a chartered accountant, and a graduate of Sciences-Po Paris and IAE Paris. He also holds a Masters degree in Philosophy from the Sorbonne. Since 1990 he has been a lecturer at Sciences-Po Paris, l'Ecole Normale Supérieure and at l'Université Paris Dauphine.
